State Tested Nurse Aide

80 hours | 3 weeks | Tuition/Fees: \$575

A Nurse Aide is responsible for providing direct resident care under the supervision of a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) or Registered Nurse (RN). The Nurse Aide program provides classroom learning, laboratory practice and supervised clinical patient care.

Students:

- Must have a clear BCI background check and negative 2-step TB test prior to class start.

Medication Aide

120 hours | 5 weeks | Tuition/Fees: \$1,175

A Medication Aide is a State Tested Nurse Aide that has completed additional classroom training to be certified to dispense medications to patients while working under the supervision of a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) or Registered Nurse (RN).

Students:

- Must have a clear BCI background check and negative 2-step TB test prior to class start.
- Must have been working as an STNA for one year

Phlebotomy

160 hours | 9 weeks | Tuition/Fees: \$1,245

A Phlebotomist is trained to draw blood via venipuncture from patients for testing, transfusions, donations, or research.

Students:

- Must have a clear BCI background check and negative 2-step TB test prior to class start.
