



Truck Driver Training Programs

Part-Time Offerings

These courses are designed to prepare students to pass the State of Ohio Commercial Driver's License (CDL) test as well as succeed in the trucking industry as a high demand, professional truck driver. Students must have a valid driver's license, pass a Department of Transportation (DOT) physical, and a drug screen.

Students:

- Must have a valid driver's license
- Must pass a DOT physical exam
- Must pass a drug screen
- 18 – 21 years of age may only drive in-state only
- Must have no more than four (4) points on his or her current license
- No DUI/DWI/OMVI motor vehicle substance convictions in the previous five (5) years

Classes are scheduled year-round based on enrollment.

Truck Driving Training - 160 Hours

- Unrestricted Class A
- 5 weeks
- Tuition/Fees: \$5,000
- Semi-Truck - Tractor Trailer

Truck Driving Training - 80 Hours

- Restricted Class A (Dump Truck & Pintle Hitch Trailer)
- Class B (Dump Truck or Water Truck)
- 3 weeks
- Tuition/Fees: \$2,500

Mid-East CTC-Adult Education Truck Driver Training Programs Entrance Requirements

Applicant is required to:

1. Complete a short term class registration form for Mid-East CTC-Adult Education (MECTC) and submit to CDL program coordinator
2. Obtain a Driver Abstract from the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (\$8.50) and submit to CDL program coordinator.
3. Submit a Copy of a valid Class D driver's license to CDL program coordinator. Driver must be licensed for minimum of one year to qualify.
4. NO BCI required.
5. Submit to a 5 panel drug screen and have a reading/result of NEGATIVE
6. Submit to and pass a Department of Transportation (DOT) physical at the Genesis Healthplex located in Zanesville, Ohio.

FEE Schedule:

MECTC will pay for and provide:

- A DOT Physical \$60.00 **NOTE: MECTC will only pay for a standard DOT physical. The costs associated with any additional testing will be the responsibility of the applicant.**
- A 5 panel drug screen \$45.00. Only a Negative reading will be accepted.
- 4 Test Fees at a cost of up to \$85.00 per test.
- Class A or Class B vehicle at the test site.

NOTE: Students not tested prior to program start will be tested within the first two days of program start date. MECTC-Adult Education will accept results from DOT physical from other licensed DOT facilities at program coordinator's inspection for validity, without any adjustment to tuition/fees.

NOTE: If a student fails either the DOT physical or 5 panel drug screen paid for by MECTC, tuition/fees will be refunded less \$100.00 for administrative expenses.

Applicant in addition to program tuition will be responsible for the following fees:

- Driver Abstract \$8.50
- Class A or Class B permit \$27.00
- Class A or Class B Driver's License \$42.00
- Hazmat fees (if desired) \$86.50
